GFWC Community Service Program Descriptions

Arts and Culture Community Service Program:

This program encourages members to participate in the study of art and culture, which enriches the human experience. Art education improves problem solving and critical thinking skills, builds focus and perseverance and nurtures creativity, confidence, and collaboration. Cultural awareness promotes effective communication and profoundly increases the ability to appreciate and enjoy a variety of new people and experiences.

Civic Engagement and Outreach Community Service Program

This CSP reminds GFWC members that each of us is a part of a larger society and is responsible for undertaking actions that will create a better quality of life and foster a sense of community – locally, regionally, nationally, and globally. The four "broad strokes" of this effort include: Citizenship; Crime Prevention, Safety and Disaster Preparedness; the Needy, Hungry, and Homeless; and Our Military Personnel and Veterans.

Education and Libraries Community Service Program:

GFWC members promote education in both children and adults. We aim to help others, while we also continue to learn. Cocoa Beach Woman's Club Code of Conduct

A code of conduct is a set of rules outlining the responsibilities of, or proper practices for, an individual, party, or organization. A code of conduct is written for members of an organization, which protects the organization and informs the members, boosters, and volunteers of the organization's expectations.

Distribution of Code of Conduct

To be transparent with the community, our members, vendor employees, boosters and volunteers, our Code of Conduct will be shared as follows: The Club's website. The Club's yearbook. A stand-alone document that is signed by each member, booster, or volunteer.

Code of Conduct

Cocoa Beach Woman's Club (the Club) is a nonprofit corporation that is educational, literary, scientific, and charitable. Participation in the Club's programs is subject to the observance of the Club's rules and procedures, as found in the Club's Bylaws and Standing Rules. The activities outlined below are strictly prohibited. Any member, booster, or volunteer who violates this Code is subject to discipline, up to and including removal from the Club.

Abusive or foul language towards a member, vendor employee, booster, or volunteer.

Reporting to a Club event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Bringing to a Club event dangerous or unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms, weapons, or other similar items.

Discourtesy or rudeness to a fellow member, vendor employee, booster, or volunteer.

Verbal, physical, or visual harassment of another member, vendor employee, booster, volunteer.

Actual or threatened violence toward any individual or group.

Conduct endangering the life, safety, health, or well-being of others.

Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any member, vendor employee, booster, or volunteer.

It is the responsibility of each member of Cocoa Beach Woman's Club to uphold the Club's Code of Conduct and to respect the rights of all members. Any member observing a violation is urged to contact a member of the Board. The Board is responsible for enforcing the Code.
